**1. Introduction by Chairman**

2. **Traffic Strategy**-Bill Baker gave a summary of the Queanbeyan City Council meeting and indicated the importance of the approval of the traffic study for progressing the approval process for the developments at Tralee and Googong. He provided a briefing on the discussions with the State and Federal members. The EO indicated the comments from QCC on the process for implementation and their impact on the Tralee and Googong projects. Ken Ineson indicated that the Tralee project would enter its public exhibition stage following the Minister for Planning's acceptance of the strategy.

**3. Crawford Street Proposal**

Chris Gibson gave a briefing on the Crawford Street consultancy let by the QCC and its coverage. He also advised of the details of the Community Consultation to be held at 5.30 on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of September. Comment was made about the issues which should be considered by the consultants. This will be the first stage of the implementation of the CBD Master Plan and also includes the process for consultation. The EO is to contact the QCC and request that the police be involved in the consultation process to provide input into security aspects, both passive and active.

4. **General Business** – The EO indicated that he had spoken to Defence Housing and the Asia Pacific School of Excellence re speaking at the next executive meeting on their activities in the region and their impact on Queanbeyan. This could be a meeting to invite all members.
